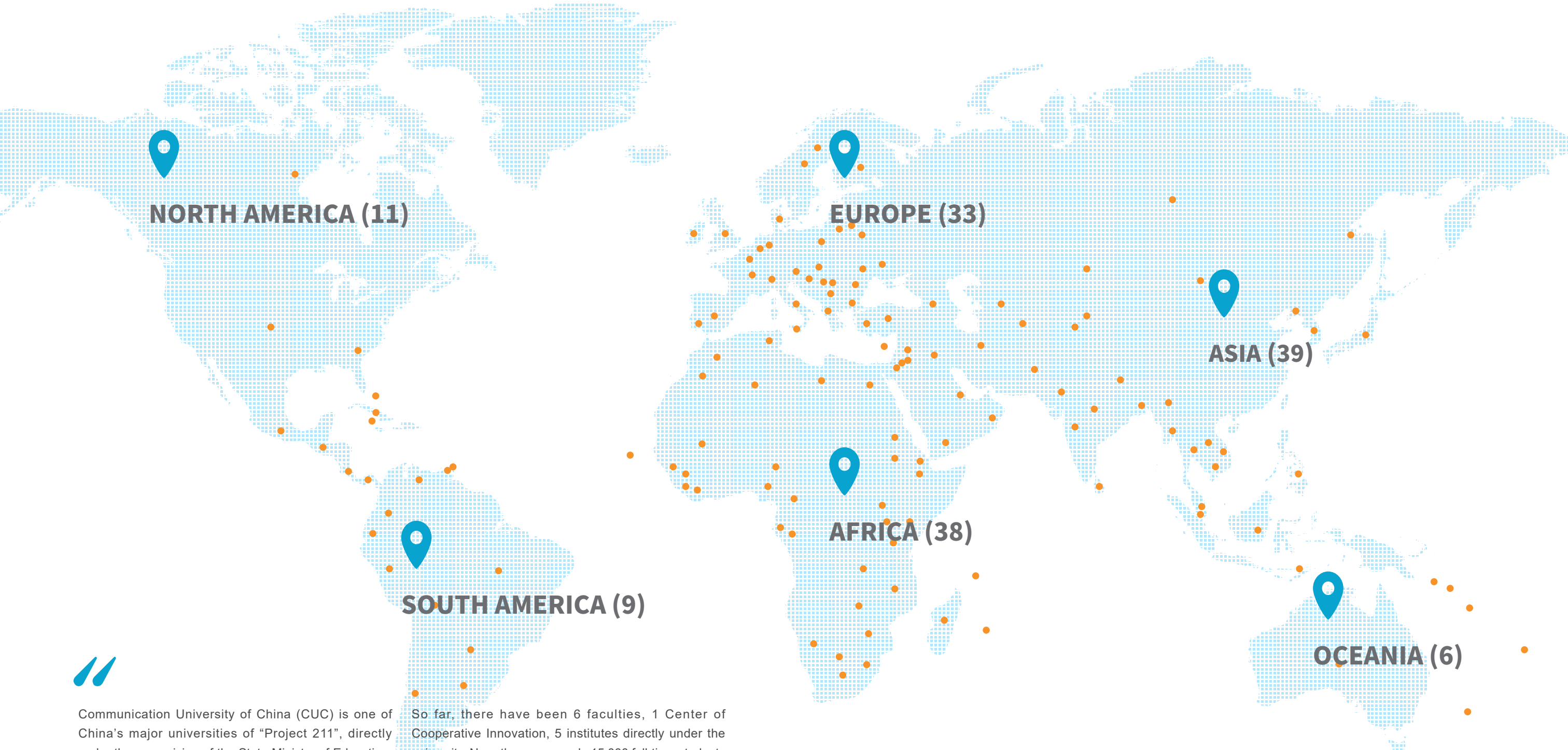

Communication University of China (CUC) is one of China's major universities of "Project 211", directly under the supervision of the State Ministry of Education. Located in the east part of Beijing, CUC occupies 463,600 square meters.

With more than 60 years history, CUC has made such a great contribution to the national business of radio and television that it has gained the fame--- "a cradle of China's radio and television talents". As the discipline evaluation results of 2012 State Ministry of Education showed that the subject "Journalism & Communication" and "Drama Film & Television" of CUC ranked the first, "Art Theory" and "Designing" ranked top 10.

So far, there have been 6 faculties, 1 Center of Cooperative Innovation, 5 institutes directly under the university. Now, there are nearly 15,000 full-time students in the CUC, including over 9,000 undergraduates, more than 4,000 candidates for doctor and master degrees, and more than 10,000 students in programs of continuing education.

CUC has established cooperative partnership with over 200 universities, research institutes, and media institutions in different countries and regions. Every year, more than 1000 international students from over 100 countries and regions study at CUC.

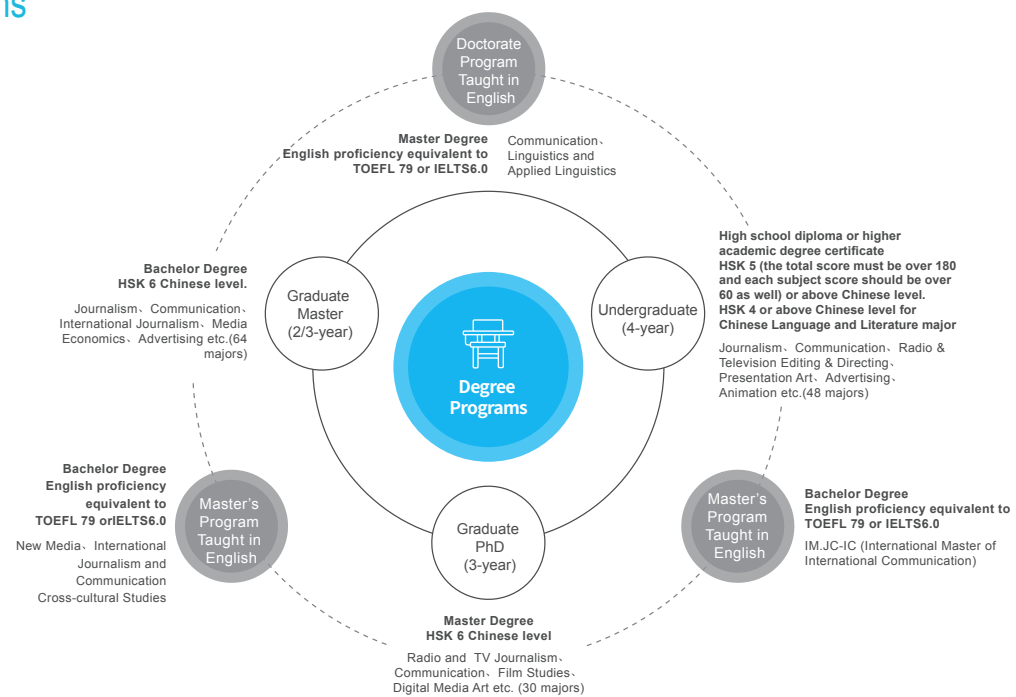

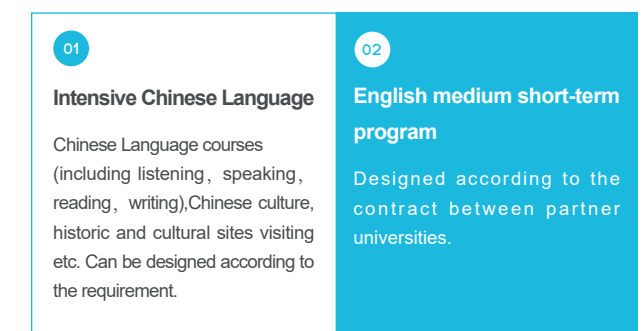
Small-class teaching intensive Chinese language courses. Elementary, medium and advanced levels available.

06 Application Requirements & Procedures

1 Application requirements

Undergraduate

Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens with valid passport or 4 years or above verification of nationality, and with over 2 years living aboard records (9 months in a year living aboard can be considered as 1 year which is subject to the entry & exit stamps) in recent 4 years (before April 30th of every academic year), between 18 and 35 years of age, with high school diploma or higher academic degree certificate, and good academic record. Applicants for majors in science should demonstrate a certain level of knowledge in mathematics and physics.

Master

Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens with valid passport, have academic credentials that equate with bachelor's degree in China, under 40 and provide academic credentials paper, at least two recommendation letters issued by associate professors or above.

Doctor

Applicants should have academic credentials that equate with master's degree in China, under 50 and provide academic credentials paper, at least two recommendation letters issued by associate professors.

Language Student

Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens with valid passport, between 18-45 years of age.

3 Online application

- 01 Log on the website <https://cuc.17gz.org/member/login.do> to register, and upload photos and application materials according to the relevant requirement.
- 02 Pay application fee online.
- 03 Wait for the qualification examination and admission.

Please note:

- ① Every applicant shall register for two major at most. All application fees are non-refundable.
- ② Please double check your application information before submission. Once the information is submitted, it cannot be changed.
- ③ Please keep a record of your application user name and password for future check and enroll results query. No inquiry service is available at the School of International Education.



4 Required Application Materials

- 01 "Warranty Letter" (Please download the "Warranty Letter" at the online registration system after your online application is confirmed at the same time, the "Warranty Letter" shall be signed by the guarantor or affix one's seal)
- 02 Scanned copy of passport (front page and visa page) and residential permit if available.
- 03 Electronic photo with white background (minimum size: 640dpi*480dpi).

Undergraduate program applicants need to attach

- 04 Scanned copy of high school diploma (or a Certificate of Expected Graduation), and high school transcript. (Original documents need to be offered for check on registration day)
- 05 One Recommendation Letter with school seal.
- 06 New HSK level-5 (or higher level) Certificate and an original copy of transcript. (students who is taught in Chinese in high school do not need to offer)

Graduate program applicants need to attach

- 04 Scanned copy of university diploma (or a Certificate of Expected Graduation), and university transcript. (Original documents need to be offered for check on registration day)
- 05 Two recommendation letters of associate professors (scanned copies)
- 06 Personal Statement: The content shall include the applicant's education and professional experience, academic achievements, research plan and the goal of development after graduation (written in the language which will be used in future lectures).
- 07 Research Plan: applicants for Master program need to write no less than 2000 characters and applicants for PhD program need to write no less than 3000 characters in the language which will be used in future lectures.
- 08 Copy of published academic papers, awards and other research achievements.
- 09 HSK level-6 Certificate and an original copy of transcript (Chinese Medium program applicable).

For English medium programs, TOFEL or IELTS reports need to be offered if the applicant's mother language is not English and his/her previous study & working experiences cannot prove his/her English level.

In addition, for those who are applying broadcasting-related majors, please provide video material. The requirements are as follow:

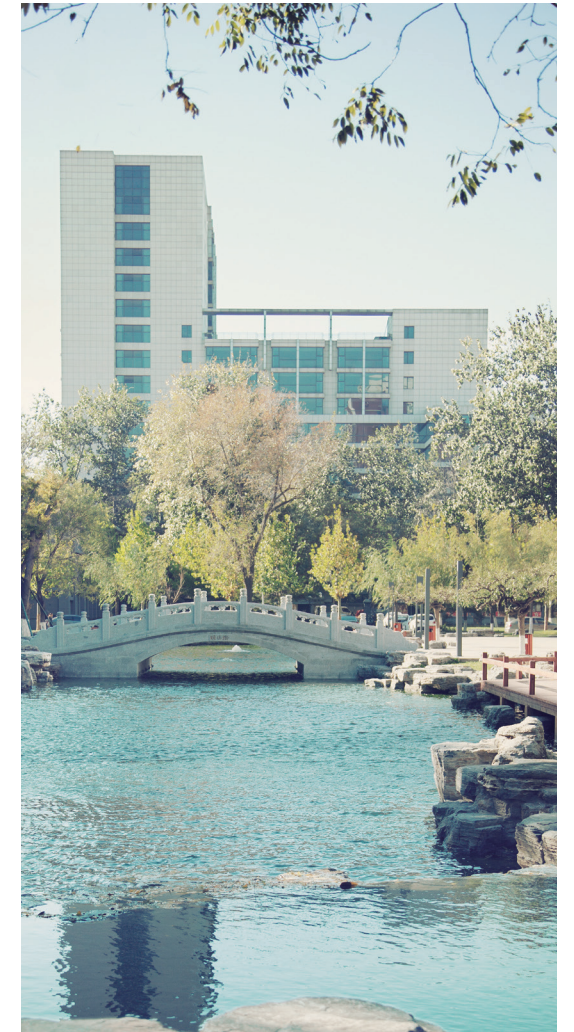
▲ Contents (9 minutes in total)

- 01 News broadcasting (3 minutes maximum, open-ended subjects)
- 02 Programme host (3 minutes maximum, open-ended subjects)
- 03 Literature reciting (3 minutes maximum, open-ended subjects)

▲ File format and medium

- 01 MP4 only
- 02 Computer readable CD

Other materials to demonstrate the applicants' talents.



Notice for foreign citizens of Chinese origin:
For those who were born overseas and got the nationalities after birth, please offer the birth certificate.
For those who have changed their nationalities from Chinese into others, please follow the provisions of "the Ministry of Education Foreign Students Education(2009 No.83" and provide the following documents:

- ① Naturalization Certification;
- ② Certification for Chinese Household Registration Cancellation;
- ③ Copy of Passport's entry and exit signature stamp pages for the last four years;
- ④ Proof of overseas education experience for the last four years (from April 30th, 2014 to April 30th, 2018) In addition, for those who was born overseas and holding a foreign nationality, please provide your birth certificate.

Please prepare the video or other works as required, submit them before March 15th or May 10th .(Applicants for Chinese Language & Literature need to come to the university and take part in the writing exam and interview.)

3> Tips for the interview

- 01 All the art and Chinese Language & Literature major applicants should come to CUC for the interview on time. CUC doesn't have other interview sites outside campus
- 02 Please confirm the information of the applicant on interview day with the passport of applicant. "Examination ID Card" will be issued then. All the applicants are required to show the passports and "Examination ID Cards" before the interview starts
- 03 Please strictly obey the rules of the interview, be in proper dress, and no smoking around the exam area. Applicants should leave the exam area immediately after the interview, and should not stay to discuss about the content of the interview. Violators will be disqualified
- 04 Accommodation and other relevant expenses during the examination should be afforded by the applicant

01 Admission result query

July 12th 2018 General Major (third batch)

Graduate applicants can log on the online application system and check the admission result & scholarship information 3 weeks after the application finished (May 30th 2018).

Language students can log on the online application system and check the admission result.

1 Registration

- 01 International students must register at the time specified in the "Letter of Admission". Students who cannot register on time due to special reasons must submit formal paper application (less than 2 weeks) to Communication University of China one week before the registration day; otherwise he/she will be regarded as giving up student status automatically
- 02 Self-supporting students should pay 1-year tuition fee on the registration day
- 03 Provide 6 2-inch white background photos on registration day
- 04 Pay the insurance fee on registration day

2 Visa

- 01 International students should hold an ordinary passport with student visa ("X" visa) to come to China; otherwise he/she may not be able to register at Communication University of China.
- 02 If you are already in China with "Residence Permit", please come to the office to pay the tuition fee and extend your visa 1 month before the expiring date.

- 01 Students with "X" visa after entering China should register at the office within 7 days, and apply for "Residence Permit" at the police station within 30 days.
- 02 Overdue will be punished by the police station, for serious violation, school will cancel your admission.

- 01 International students who hold student visa ("X" visa) should provide all the original medical examination results to International Student Office, including: the "Physical Examination Record for Foreigner", blood lab reports for AIDS and Syphilis, ECG report, X-ray report. The report will be valid in 6 months, overdue, you should do it again.
- 02 All the information above is subject to change by the School of International Education.
